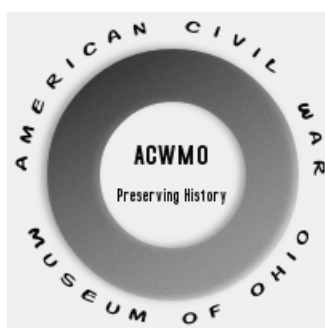


History is not only about the past. It also influences our present and our future.

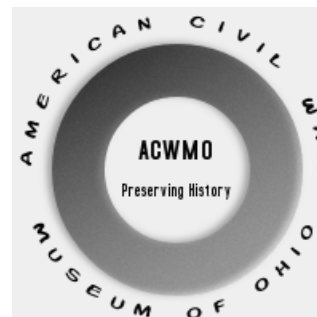

Museum Exhibits

The Soldiers Life. This exhibit helps the visitor understand the daily routine and hardships that the Civil War soldier learned to endure.

Medicine. The focus of this exhibit is on the inadequate medical care available during the conflict. Sickness, battlefield casualties, and medical training are discussed.

Prisoners of War. This exhibit discusses the POW experience and how it influenced the outcome of the war. Johnson's Island prisoner of war camp is featured in this exhibit.

Ohio in the Civil War. This exhibit explores Ohio's role in the Civil War.

Put it on. Children can dress in reproduction Civil War era clothing and wear the soldiers gear.

Naval Operations. Hampton Roads, the blockade, and the sinking of the Sultana are just the beginning.

Diorama Room. See several dioramas depicting major battles during the Civil War.

GAR/Civilian. Dozens of ribbons, markers, and one of a kind homemade pieces.
